The program is designed to fund projects in the following broad categories. Projects may contain elements of all categories with at least one community capacity activity.

- Group Maintenance Grants - up to \$500 to cover group costs (e.g insurance, postage)
- Promotion and Education Grants - up to \$2,000 for projects focusing on awareness

raising, education and training activities.

- Major Integrated Project Grants - up to \$10,000 for on-ground activities e.g revegetation and weed control projects.

Up to \$5 million will be made available in 2008, through various funding streams, to support additional water within geographical areas of greater metropolitan Melbourne and regional urban Victoria.

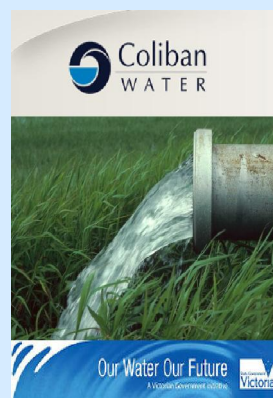
There is funding available to any individual, community group, commercial enterprise or profes-
